Howard College offers an Associate of Applied Science program in Respiratory Care. Graduates of this program are eligible to take the National Board for Respiratory Care Entry Level and Advanced Level Examination. Individuals who pass this examination are awarded the Certified Respiratory Therapist (CRT) credential. Once the CRT credential is earned, graduates may take the NBRC Written Registry and Clinical Simulation exams. Candidates who pass these exams earn the Registered Respiratory Therapist (RRT) credential.
