

NOTICE OF TAX REVENUE INCREASE

The Howard County Junior College District conducted public hearings on August 13, 2012 and August 17, 2012 on a proposal to increase the total tax revenues of the Howard County Junior College District from properties on the tax roll in the preceding year by 4.82 percent.

The total tax revenue proposed to be raised last year at last year's tax rate of \$0.238507 for each \$100 of taxable value was \$6,006,885.

The total tax revenue proposed to be raised this year at the proposed tax rate of \$0.176616 for each \$100 of taxable value, excluding tax revenue to be raised from new property added to the tax roll this year, is \$6,291,806.

The total tax revenue proposed to be raised this year at the proposed tax rate of \$0.176616 for each \$100 of taxable value, including tax revenue to be raised from new property added to the tax roll this year, is \$6,302,240.

The Howard County Junior College District is scheduled to vote on the tax rate that will result in that tax increase at a public meeting to be held on August 27, 2012 at Tumbleweed Rm., Howard County Junior College District, 1001 Birdwell Ln., Big Spring TX 79720 at 12:30 PM.
