<p>Welcome- Dr. Cheryl T. Sparks</p>	<p>Dr. Sparks explained to student's the procedure for this meeting. Issues presented at the meeting today will be addressed at Student Roundtable next Spring 2018.</p>
<p>PowerPoint Meeting 3/8/17 Nancy Bonura</p>	<p>Nancy showed PowerPoint of meeting held March 8, 2017 detailing issues that students addressed during meeting. Dr. Sparks addressed all issues.</p>
<p>Activity Center- Student</p>	<p>Students shared they would like to have trainers for basketball and volleyball games. Wooden benches need to be removed. Nancy shared this has already been discussed and benches will be removed soon. Lights in gym are too bright, need to dim them for the volleyball players. Students would like to have new SWCID logo on floor of gym and on the wall, and Rattler logo placed on side area of gym floor. Students would like to have different stations in weight room to work out so they don't have to wait for a long time when someone is working out. We need more volleyball games. Students would like to see a table for the scorekeepers like they have at Howard College, it is safer for the players. They would like to have mirrors in weight room to watch students form, and mirrors for cheer practice, with a separate room on far side of gym.</p>
<p>Gym- Student</p>	<p>Students would like to have a new gym, one for practice and one for games, or have two separate gyms one for girls and one for boys.</p>
<p>Television- Student</p>	<p>Students would like to have a place to watch videos of basketball/volleyball games and a bigger TV. Nancy shared this was on the list to add an Athletic Lounge from a private donor's gift.</p>

Intramural Sports- Student	Student shared they would like to have an Astroturf field to play on. Since there are so many prairie dog holes, they can't play.
Uniforms- Student	Students would like to change volleyball uniforms and have more options.
International Students Insurance/Storage Students	Students are needing help in getting insurance. Nancy shared this is not up to the college, but will look into insurance options. Students would like to have a place where they can store their things when they go home for the summer.
Dorms- Students	Students shared we need to install doorbells in dorm lobby/dorm office. Since doors are locked when they deliver Pizza, no one is at the front. They shared three washing machines were not working and need to get fixed or purchase new washing machines.
Cameras- Students	Students shared we need more security cameras for parking lot and dorms. Nancy shared this is a work in progress and is planned to be accomplished soon.
MSC/Snack Bar/- Students	Students would like to open a small café to purchase snacks and store where they can purchase pens, paper, USB's, etc., so they don't have to buy from the bookstore.
Tutorial Center- Student	Student shared we need another math tutor in tutorial center.
Cafeteria- Students	Students would like to see a healthier variety of food options in the cafeteria. They would like to have a station for ketchup and mustard instead of bottles. They presently do not have a Food Committee, but will meet and set up a committee.
SWCID Website- Student	Student shared that SWCID website needs changes, always the same.
Summarization of Meeting- Students	Students complimented the new lighting on site and painting of the dorms. Instructors are great and trip to Wichita Falls Regional Day School f/t Deaf was a great experience. Students shared their appreciation of the new score board.
