

# Scholarships for Howard College San Angelo

## Howard College San Angelo General Scholarship

The Howard College San Angelo General Scholarship is awarded to qualified students for the Fall, Spring, and Summer semesters. The scholarship amount varies depending on the amount of funding available and the number of scholarships to be awarded to those qualified. Must be a Howard College San Angelo student pursuing a Howard College San Angelo degree. Enrolled in a minimum of 3 hours with a minimum GPA of 2.5.

## Frank Junell Health Professions Scholarship

The Frank Junell Health Professions Scholarship is awarded to a Health Professions student who demonstrates high scholastic achievement, financial need, and motivation to succeed in a Health Professions program. The scholarship will be awarded for each academic year and the recipient will receive the \$1,250.00 scholarship for both fall and spring semesters for the purchase of books, tuition and fees, or other educational expenses each semester.

## Wolslager Foundation Scholarship

The Wolslager Foundation has graciously donated scholarship money to Howard College San Angelo to be awarded to selected applicants to further their education. The funds be may be used for tuition, fees, and books. The student must be enrolled full-time at Howard College San Angelo with a minimum GPA of 2.5. The student must have graduated from a high school within the counties of Tom Green, Concho, Irion, Sterling, Runnels, Brown, McCulloch, Coke, Mills, Crockett, or Schleicher or have been a resident of one of these counties for at least five (5) years. Multiple scholarships may be awarded to qualified students in the amount of \$1,250.00 for both Fall and Spring semesters.

## Howard College San Angelo Foundation Scholarship

The Howard College San Angelo Foundation has graciously donated scholarship money to Howard College San Angelo to be awarded to selected applicants to further their education. Multiple scholarships may be awarded based on the funds available and the number of scholarship applications received. The student must be a HCSA student pursuing a HCSA degree or a HCSA Dual Credit student. Must have a minimum GPA of 2.5 and must be enrolled in a minimum of 6 college credit hours for each semester. Must be a U.S. citizen.

## Justin Callan Memorial Scholarship
